
Electric Servo Motors & Automation

Servo motors come in a variety of different types and styles, each with its own unique set of features and capabilities. Here are the top 4 most used in the industry.




The Most Common: DC Servo Motors

- Often used in robotics and automation




The Popular One: Brush-less DC
